CityNorth announces retail lineup for City Center project

CityNorth has announced several retailers and restaurants for its mixed-use project at 56th Street and Loop 101 in north Phoenix.

Pioneer Stores USA will open Arizona's first such electronics store and feature extensive consumer electronics and installation services, ranging from home theater to in-car navigation, video and audio services.

"We chose CityCenter of CityNorth to open our second U.S. store because we believe Pioneer's premium brand positioning aligns with CityNorth's progressive shoppers' interests for the latest ground-breaking and lifestyle enhancing products," said Jeff Hagg, national retail manager for Pioneer, in a statement.

In addition to the Pioneer store, bebe, Bobby Chan, Lens Crafters and restaurants, Press Coffee Food Wine, Mojo Yogurt and Saito's Japanese Steak House have also been announced for the project.

CityNorth is being developed in phases and features several areas, including High Street. Set to open Nov. 13, High Street is expected to include more than 40 retail stores and eight restaurants comprising nearly 180,000 square feet.

The project will also include 39 private condominiums called The Residences on High Street and The Residences on High Street Luxury Rentals, which include 60 luxury rental units.

The second phase of the project is expected to open in the fall of 2010 and will feature shops and restaurants, including Macy's, Arizona's first Bloomingdale's and Nordstrom, as well as condos, Class A office space and community gathering spaces.
